<u>Ysbyty Gwynedd Roundabout</u> Whilst the roundabout itself and the one crossing are to be praised for their finish, the yellow lines at Coed y Maes have still not been reinstalled

Chair to contact the Gwynedd Officer to express his disappointment as well as to enquire about the location of the crossing on the Bangor side

<u>The Flower Box</u> had arrived with soil included - **Clerk to contact the gardener to obtain plants**<u>External Auditors</u> The Chair had raised an 'official complaint' with the response time coming to an end next week

<u>Treborth Footpath</u> An order had been made to register it and a request submitted for the footpath to be resurfaced – **Gwynedd Council was trying to arrange a resurfacing agreement with the landowner**

Information Request No response had been received and 6 weeks had passed

Cllr M Jones had attended a meeting of the 'River Trust' on the River Cegin. It would be a good idea to invite someone to come to meet us. **Cllr M Jones to contact to make arrangements**

<u>Traffic Prohibition</u> A notice of road closure from JLS Roundabout to the Treborth Roundabout. The timetable for this work has slipped and a second notice like the original one refers to turning right at the junction in Nant y Mount rather than turning all vehicles left towards the roundabout at the bottom of Faenol Hill and then back up. **Clerk to contact Gwynedd**

Glasinfryn Art Exhibition An excellent exhibition and over 60 people had visited

Roadside Cutting It was noted that some of our country roads were now tunnels as landowners had not been cutting their hedges for several years. Gwynedd Council was responsible for cutting roadsides and the lowest metre of the hedges. Clerk to contact Gwynedd Council to ask them to make contact and order the landowners to cut their hedges above the lowest metre

It was agreed to obtain a price from an Electrician and then to move on with the Kitchen, the Painting and the Water

Request to install another bench at the Cemetery – ashes section

A request had been received to install an 'in memory' bench in the ashes section Bearing in mind that we already have 2 benches and our intention to place two on the wild Flower meadow, some concern was expressed regarding how many similar applications we were likely to receive. It was agreed that consideration should be given to having a policy before agreeing to move further

The Condition of Public Footpaths

A request had been received from Felinheli asking whether we had data/information on the condition of our public footpaths as Y Felinheli Council does, although that mentions the condition of their footpaths in 2017.

Before giving further consideration, it would be necessary to consider costs and also how much value it would be unless reviewed on a regular basis

Our footpaths are cut annually with efforts made to resolve any problems
